The 168-page book includes 13 poems by Sharma that have a Nepali touch and provide the readers with an insight into the Nepali social milieu and its unique indigenous traditions and lifestyles. Sharma has also traced the history of conquering Everest in those poems. Along with the poems, there are 122 beautiful panoramic photographs by Stimm who has captured the myth and the spirit of the region along the journey that starts at the mountain village of Lukla, moves along the valleys beside the Dudh Koshi river and continues up to Namche Bazar. His photographic coverage also includes the Tengboche monastery, the magnificent views of Nuptse and Lhotse, the Khumbu glacier and the famous viewpoint of Kala Patthar.
